Call for Researchers

Presentation of the project

Youth Anti Radicalisation through Sport in Europe (YARSPE) is a three years (2020-2022) project funded by the European Commission and is a collaboration between Fare network, [INEX – Sdruzeni Dobrovolnych Aktivit](#), [GEA](#), [Fundacja dla Wolności](#). The project aims at creating tools for coaches, teachers and sport associations to prevent radicalisation among youth by collaborating with local organisations, institutions and public authorities, and prevent discrimination and extremism of all forms by organising sport activities for young people at risk of different forms of radicalisation.

The YARSPE team is looking for 2 researchers/ academics with knowledge on the field of radicalisation and sport, to analyse the results of the comparative local research, monitor and evaluate the results of the activities, and develop an Analytical Report merging the theory, policy and practices.

Role

The two selected researchers will work together in analysing, observing and jointly extract successful methods and prepare a final Analytical Report. The Analytical Report will contain the theory, policy and practices in the field of anti-radicalisation and sport. The researchers will work in close collaboration with YARSPE team and report to Fare network.

Profile

- PhD or practitioner in the field of radicalisation/ counter radicalisation and knowledgeable in sport;
- With a background preferably in (psychology, education, security, social studies);
- At least 1-year experience in the field of research and analysis, able to prepare reports for a diverse audience;
- Prior experience in Monitoring and Evaluation process;
- Fluent in English;
- Able to perform in an intercultural environment;
- Prepared to work in a flexible scheme;
- Available for occasional travel: 1 meeting with Fare network in Amsterdam, attendance to 1 event in Italy, Czech Republic and Hungary, as well as the final conference of the project.
